1. **Distinguished Service Award**

*Division of Environmental Chemistry*

2. **Purpose.** To recognize sustained and distinguished contributions to the field of environmental chemistry and to the Division.
3. **Nature.** The award consists of a certificate and a lifetime Honorary Membership in the Division. Division dues for recipients will be remitted for life provided continuous membership is maintained in the American Chemical Society.
4. **Establishment and Support.** This award was established by the Division in 1957.
5. **Rules of Eligibility.** The nominee must be a member of the Division for at least ten years and must have demonstrated activity and support of the Division through papers presented, organizing symposia, effective work on Division committees, regular attendance and participation at national meetings, holding office in the Division, and a general attitude and willingness to help in Divisional work.
6. **Frequency of Presentation.** The award is presented at the fall national ACS meeting if a recipient has been chosen.
7. **Single or Multiple Recipients.** No limit is placed on the number of recipients.

*Division of Environmental Chemistry*

2. *Purpose.* To recognize notable first presentations before the Division.
3. *Nature.* The award consists of a certificate and a guest invitation for the Division's dinner during the national ACS meetings.
4. *Establishment and Support.* The award was established by the Division in 1980.
5. *Rules of Eligibility.* Nominees must be members of the American Chemical Society and have not previously presented a paper before the Division. Both oral and poster presentations are eligible.
6. *Frequency of Presentation.* The awards are presented at the Division's dinner during the national ACS meeting following the meeting at which the paper was presented.
7. *Single or Multiple Recipients.* No limit is placed on the number of recipients.
