

Minutes of the Annual Business Meeting of the Division of Water, Air, and Waste Chemistry, August 29, 1972, held at the Waldorf-Astoria Hotel, New York City, New York.

The Annual Business Meeting was called to order at 4:30 p.m. by the Chairman, Robert A. Baker.

The minutes from the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Treasurer's report was passed to the membership with a tabulation of Division members. The report was accepted as written.

The Nominating Committee report of Dr. F. L. Estes was read by the Chairman. This report was as follows:

Request for nominations from the floor was then made and none received. A move that the nominations be closed was made, seconded and carried. The Slate of Officers, as proposed by the Nominating Committee, were elected unanimously.

A report from the Awards Committee was presented by Paul Morgan.

Dr. Baker then issued a request for any new business.

A motion was made by Dr. David Chen to change the name of the Division to the Division of Environmental Chemistry. The motion was seconded and unanimously carried. Dr. T. E. Larsen then stated that this motion would have to be referred to the Executive Council for its meeting in Dallas.

The meeting was adjourned after a motion and seconding by the Chairman, Dr. Baker, at 4:50 p.m.
