Business Meeting Minutes
Miami, Florida
September 11, 1989

The minutes of the 1988 Business Meeting in Los Angeles were read by Gordon Bellen. A motion to accept the minutes was forwarded by Dr. A. Elzerman and seconded by Dr. C. Haile. The motion passed by voice vote.

Chairman, Dr. Dean Adams, summarized the major items of discussion from the Executive Committee Meeting of September 10, 1989. The new Division By-Laws have been approved by the ACS Committee on By-Laws. The Division's Articles of Incorporation have been approved and will be read at the 1990 Fall meeting in Washington, DC. The nominations for candidates for Executive Committee Offices was read by Dean Adams. Dr. R. Minear moved that the nominations be closed. Dr. J. F. Wikes second the motion. The motion passed by voice vote.

Chairman Adams reviewed progress on the Division Operations Handbook. The Handbook is in the final draft stages.

New Business

Dr. Robert Jolley suggested that symposia organizers receive additional recognition for their efforts on behalf of the Division. After lengthy discussion, Dr. Jolley moved that the Division recognize symposium organizers with a one year free membership if they are not members already or an additional copy of meeting preprints if they are members. The motion was seconded by Ellen Gonter. The motion passed, seven for, one against.

Dr. Minear offered a motion that the meeting be adjourned. The motion was seconded by Dr. Haile. The motion passed by voice vote.
