The offer by ACS Publications Marketing to reduce the cost of subscriptions to Environmental Science & Technology to division members was discussed. The annual election will be published in the next issue of EnvirofACS. Attendees had several good suggestions for improving the division's service to its members including:

- publish generic information in EnvirofACS about how to find the location of the Executive Committee Meeting, i.e. how to find out from ACS Operations at the meeting; suggest contacting division officers just prior to the meeting, etc. Often the exact location is not known at the time the preprints are published, and the preprints are received too late by overseas members.
- publish information on potential symposia a year in advance in EnvirofACS
- notices of Division activities published in C&EN need to appear earlier
- include information on Environmental Divisional activities on the ACS Gopher Server
