- Acid Aerosols
- Material Damage from Pollution and Associated Chemistry
- Biotechnology for Wastewater Treatment
- Risk Assessment
- Risk of Water Reuse - Waste Water to Drinking Water
- Indoor Air Monitoring
- Radon
- Shallow Aquifer Chemistry
- Wetlands Chemistry
- Aquatic Toxicity Testing and Associated Chemistry
