The issue of giving ES&T to non-member awardees was discussed and Jurgen agreed to bring the issue up at the board meeting. We have been running the awards program considerably into the red by paying non-member premiums and we need to either increase the budget or look for alternative awards.

The latest ACS data indicates that the Division had 100% retention of membership going into the first quarter. We're skeptical of the data.

We reviewed a CEI draft energy policy statement and commented that it needed some discussion of conservation and something specific on global warming.

The program to certify environmental chemists was discussed. The program seems to be in trouble. It was suggested that the program might be more successful if moved to a function more concerned with professional relations. Ted Mill suggested we should put something in EnvirofACS.
